- 1. **Meeting was called to order** at 7:00 P.M. by Smith
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. **Roll Call**: **Present**: Richardson, Meert, Smith, Sell, Hephner Also Present: Attorney Kaufman
- 4. Agenda: Motion made by Smith, supported by Hephner, to accept the agenda with the addition of Gypsy Moth Seminar under Old Business. All yes, motion carried.
- 5. Consent Agenda: Motion made by Richardson, supported by Sell to approve the Consent Agenda. All yes, motion carried.
- 6. Monthly Bills: Motion made by Hephner, supported by Smith to pay the monthly bills as presented in the amount of \$40,966.45. All yes, motion carried.
- 7. **Public Comment**: A resident asked that if you have a person open burning for 5 days straight, how would one handle it. Smith advised them to call the fire department. A resident inquired about future information on gypsy moths and Smith stated that the township is attempting to set up an additional seminar in January, to look on the Pine Grove website for dates and times.
